QUEEN, ROBERT H., Private

Resided in Haywood County where he enlisted at age 25, March 17, 1862. Present or accounted for until he deserted on August 29, 1862. Returned to duty on July 1, 1863, but deserted again on August 17, 1863.

REECE, AMOS M., Private

Resided in Haywood County where he enlisted at age 20, June 29, 1861. Present or accounted for until he died in hospital at Grahamville, South Carolina, December 25, 1861, of "pneumonia."

REECE, ISAAC N., Private

Resided in Haywood County where he enlisted at age 21, June 29, 1861. Present or accounted for until killed at Malvern Hill, Virginia, July 1, 1862.

REECE, JOHN V., Musician

Resided in Haywood County where he enlisted at age 17, July 13, 1861. Mustered in as Musician. Present or accounted for until discharged on or about September 14, 1861, by reason of "disability caused by an old cut on his foot." Later served as Corporal in Company I, 62nd Regiment N.C. Troops.

REECE, JONATHAN K., Private

Resided in Haywood County and enlisted in Buncombe County at age 23, August 6, 1861. Present or accounted for through February, 1865.

REECE, WILLIAM L., Private

Resided in Haywood County where he enlisted at age 25, June 29, 1861. Present or accounted for until he deserted on August 29, 1862. Returned to duty on an unspecified date but deserted again on or about March 27, 1863. Reported under arrest in July-August, 1863, and was reported in confinement at Castle Thunder Prison, Richmond, Virginia, in September-October, 1863. Reported under arrest at Weldon in November-December, 1863. Executed on February 18, 1864, "for murdering G. W. Chambers" while a deserter.

RHODES, WILLIAM B., Private

Resided in Haywood County where he enlisted at age 24, June 29, 1861. Present or accounted for until he died at Grahamville, South Carolina, January 30-31, 1862, of "typhoid fever."

ROBERSON, ISAAC W., Private

Resided in Haywood County where he enlisted at age 20, June 29, 1861. Mustered in as Corporal but was reduced to ranks on April 28, 1862. Present or accounted for through February, 1865.

ROGERS, JOHN C., Private

Resided in Haywood County and enlisted at age 23, June 29, 1861. Mustered in as Private and was promoted to Sergeant on or about April 30, 1862. Reduced to ranks on September 30, 1862. Present or accounted for through February, 1865.

ROGERS, MATHEW McA., Private

Resided in Haywood County where he enlisted at age 22, July 18, 1861. Present or accounted for through June, 1863; however, he was reported absent sick during much of that period. Listed as a deserter and dropped from the rolls of the company on July 8, 1863. Returned

to duty on September 21, 1863. Present or accounted for until transferred to Company A, 19th Regiment N.C. Troops (2nd Regiment N.C. Cavalry), November 16, 1864. Deserted prior to reporting to his new unit. Went over to the enemy on an unspecified date. Took the Oath of Allegiance at Knoxville, Tennessee, on or about March 10, 1865.

SCOTT, JAMES P., Private

Enlisted at "Pearson" on June 10, 1864, for the war. Present or accounted for until appointed Sergeant Major on January 1, 1865, and transferred to the Field and Staff of this regiment.

SINGLETON, JAMES ANDERSON, Corporal

Resided in Haywood County where he enlisted at age 21, August 14, 1861. Mustered in as Private. Present or accounted for until wounded at Sharpsburg, Maryland, September 17, 1862. Returned to duty in November-December, 1862. Promoted to Corporal in March-December, 1864. Present or accounted for through February, 1865.

SINGLETON, JAMES M., Private

Resided in Haywood County where he enlisted at age 20, March 18, 1862. Present or accounted for until he died in hospital at Petersburg, Virginia, January 4, 1863, of "typhoid pneumonia."

SINGLETON, JOHN C., Private

Resided in Buncombe County where he enlisted at age 26, July 30, 1861. Mustered in as Private and was promoted to Corporal on October 16, 1861. Reduced to ranks on April 30, 1862. Present or accounted for through February, 1865.

SINGLETON, SAMUEL P., Private

Resided in Haywood County and enlisted at age 24, April, 1863, for the war. Present or accounted for until discharged in June, 1863, by reason of disability. [May have served previously in Company I, 62nd Regiment N.C. Troops.]

SINGLETON, WILLIAM A. S. C., Private

Born in Greenville District, South Carolina, and resided in Haywood County where he was by occupation a farmer prior to enlisting in Haywood County at age 17, August 14, 1861. Present or accounted for until discharged on July 16, 1862, by reason of being under age.

SMITH, JOHN A., Musician

Previously served as Private in Company G of this regiment. Transferred to this company and was appointed Musician (Fifer) on May 1, 1862. Present or accounted for until wounded in the jaw at King's School House, Virginia, June 25, 1862. Returned to duty on October 11, 1862. Present or accounted for until he deserted on March 27, 1863.

SORRELLS, HENRY JACKSON, Corporal

Resided in Haywood County where he enlisted at age 23, June 29, 1861. Mustered in as Private and was promoted to Corporal on April 28, 1862. Present or accounted for until he died in hospital at Petersburg, Virginia, July 30, 1862, of "febris typhoides."

STAMEY, JOHN, Private

Resided in Haywood County where he enlisted at age
